






Hubs & spokes are set up and health workers are trained as above on how to use the virtual conferencing equipment at RRH, District and High volume Health facilities








• Community of practice sessions runs weekly as well as MoH and partner meetings



Drug Resistance ECHO Attendance by cadre




Need more social workers, nurses, lab staff and pharmacists to attend the ECHO sessions since they joint manage the PLHIVs

Trend of attendance by month from Oct 2020-Sept 2021




- Participants' love the case presentations and discussions at the ECHO sessions

5. The objectives of the session(s) were clearly defined [The objectives of the sessions were met]




98% of the respondents asserted that the objectives of the session were met while 2% did not respond

6. The objectives of the session(s) were clearly defined [The topics were easy to follow]




While 94% strongly agreed that the topics being addressed are relevant and easy to follow

Health facility based committees are discussing the cases





1.5 Number of regular participants in ECHO sessions (average per session)	Actual registration: exact trends to be reported	80
1.6 Number of HIV related cases presented in ECHO sessions	150 (2-4 cases/ session)	165
1.7 % of spokes that present at least one case during an ECHO session	70%	44%
1.8 % of RRHs equipped and Implementing the ECHO model for tele training/ mentorship	50%	93%

Note: For indicator 1.7, since not all 267 spokes are connected on the HIV DR ECHO sessions, the achievement looks small at 44%




